The home featured on our cover is the Aquarella, located in Spring Lake Pointe, in Altamonte Springs. This is the personal home of Graciela and Horacio, and as in all of their projects, is an example of the adventure they create through use of light, space and panoramic views. This home, located on Lake Silver, was the first-place winner in the category of Custom Builder Winner, \$2,000,000 – \$2,500,000 for the Metro Orlando Home Builders Association.

This house, which covers a total of 10,000 square feet (6,000 under air), has five bedrooms, a living-bonus room, seven bathrooms, a third-floor study, a four-car garage and complete guest quarters, which is used as the Silver Sea company office.

Reflecting a Mediterranean and Neo-Classic style, this home is truly unique.

The initial entrance to the home is through an iron gate, which leads to a luxurious outdoor living area. This area was created with the intention of providing an exterior entrance to the interior of the home, as well as providing an outdoor haven rich in details pleasing to the senses.

The atmosphere of this initial entrance to the home creates an environment for relaxation and serenity, with two sitting areas, accented with soft fabrics, a fireplace and a complete view of the pool. Tropical plants, such as papaya, pineapple and flowers, chosen to attract butterflies, add to the ambiance, along with the sound of the waterfall.

There is a bridge, accented with columns, that leads from this area, across the pool, to the front door entrance to the home, providing views of the pool along the way through open spaces and majestic columns.

The main entrance is a magnificent double Cedro wooden door from Argentina. The Spanish cream and ivory tile provides the flooring and leads to a stunning sitting area, accented by an integral window along the back of the room, designed to provide a view of the lake behind the property, and appears to be "in the air" since the ground is not visible from the view.

A marble arched foyer entrance leads to the master suite and master bath area, and is accented with custom Argentinean designed furniture, and combines contemporary and traditional touches. Hand-chosen traditional marble, in combination with more contemporary sink and lighting fixtures, create a luxurious atmosphere.

The kitchen, also on the first floor, features elegance in custom-built, cream-

colored wooden cabinets, and range hood, with chocolate brown chiseled accents. Granite and marble countertops, high-end stainless steel appliances and unique lighting accents provide a perfect kitchen setting. Another sitting area near the kitchen for family gatherings is also accented with light through many windows, luxurious fabrics and a custom-made entertainment center dividing this room from the front entrance sitting area.

A spiral iron and wood staircase leads to the second floor, which houses another sitting area and four bedrooms. The west wing of the home is the location of the girls' rooms and bath areas; these rooms also provide integral window views of the property. The east wing continues a similar design, with the boys' rooms and baths as well.

In the sitting area of the second-floor, there is another iron and wood spiral staircase that leads to a third-floor office and is accented with hand-painted murals on the ceiling, and another amazing view of the lake in back of the property.

The foyer of the second-floor sitting area leads to another door opening, and across a bridge over the pool to the guest quarters, which is the location of the Silver Sea office.

In the true and unique style of Silver Sea Homes, Inc., this home is magnificent with too many details to mention.
